- More precise targeting of the EuroMAB contribution to climate change, in association with the Lima Action Plan and Sustainable Development Goals.

### Expected outcomes

- Defining the aspects of the struggle against climate change in more tangible terms in order to enhance the impact of the network;
- Forming a delegation of the biosphere reserves who wish to work on setting up a programme of annual scientific expeditions in partnership with Students on Ice
