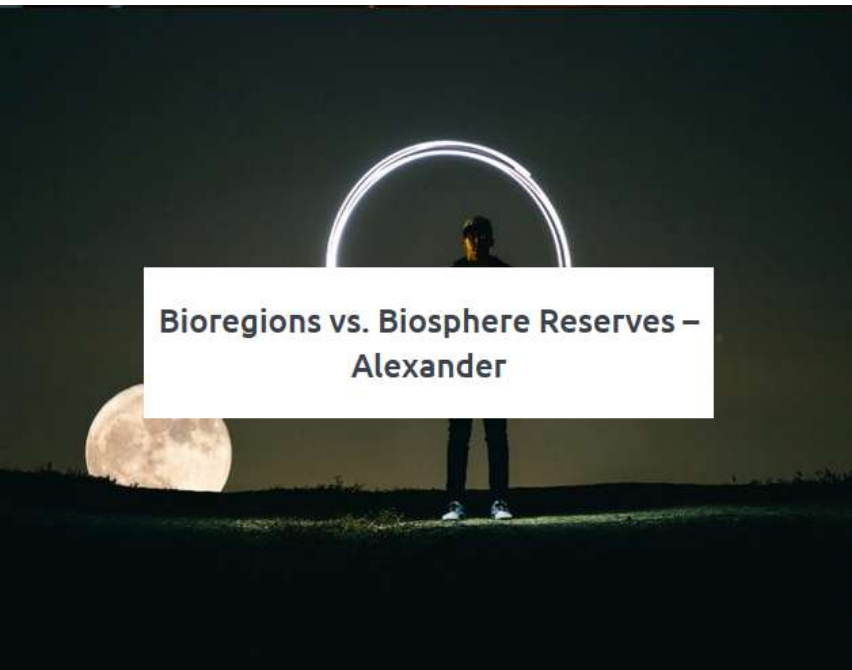

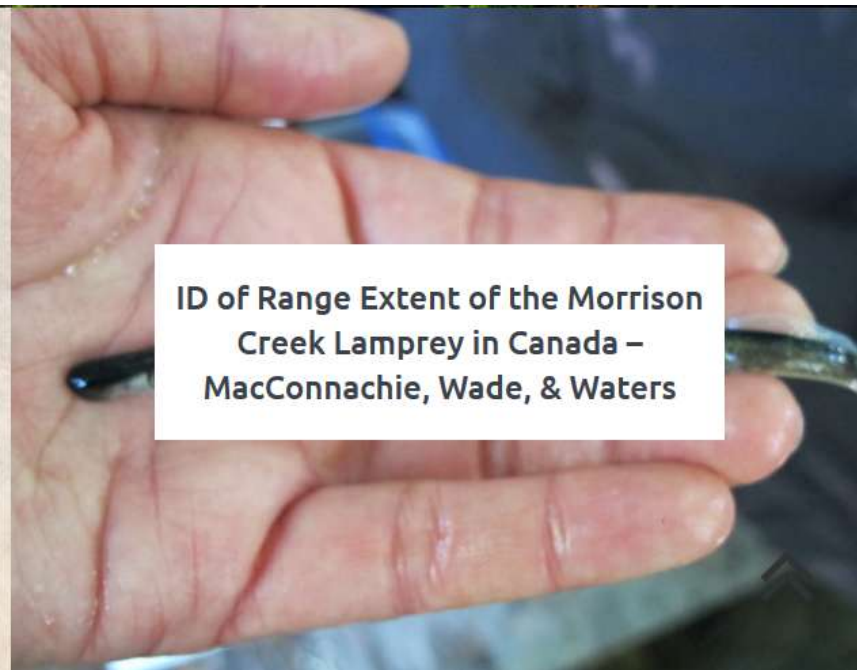

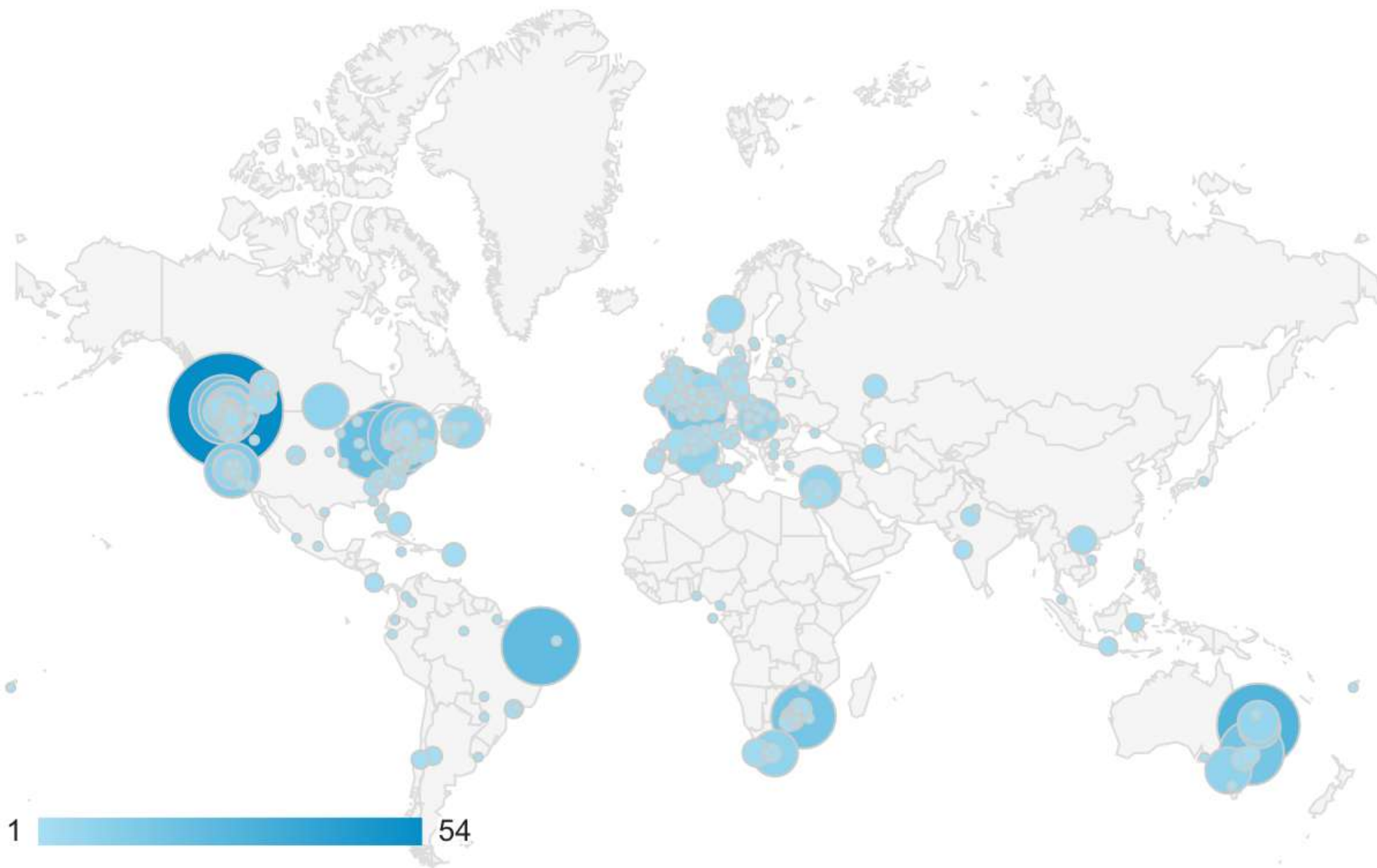

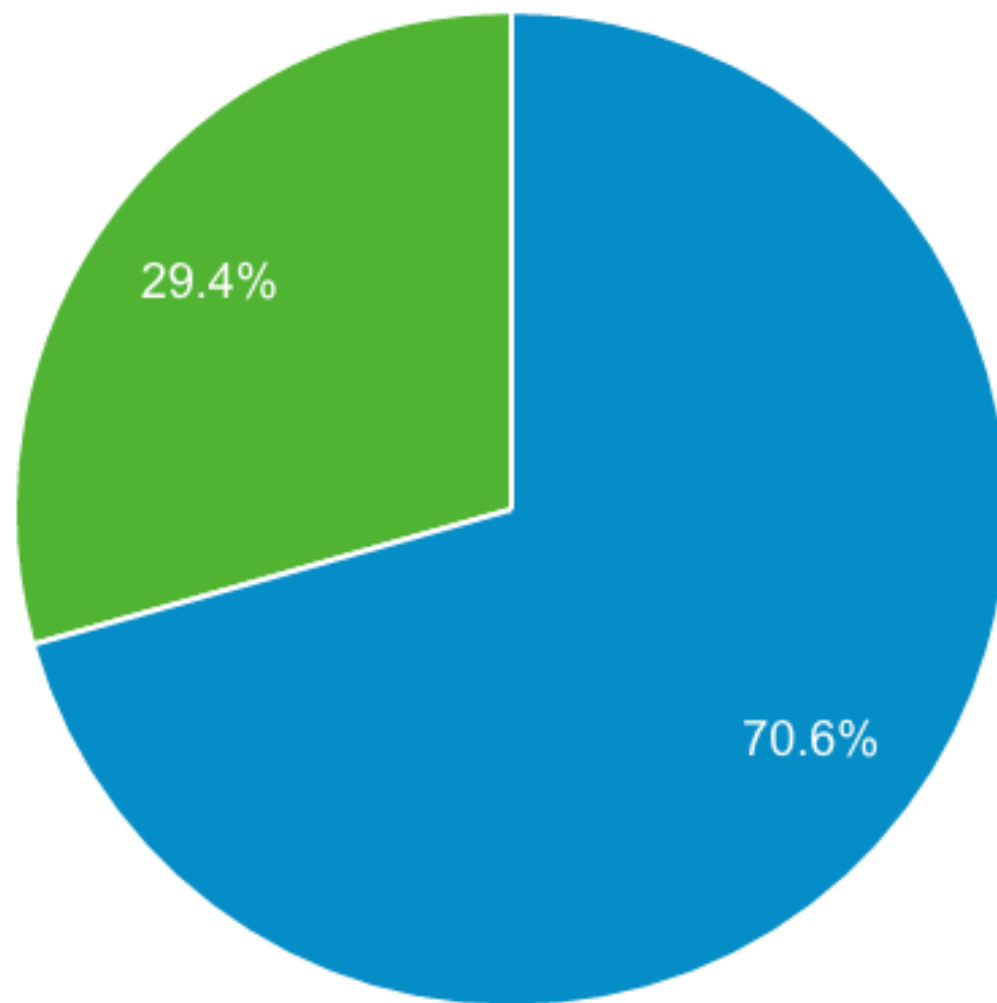
**ID of Range Extent of the Morrison
